<b>Scene Size-Up</b>			
Determines scene is safe.	1		(CPI)
Introduces self, obtains permission to examine/treat.	1		
Initiates Standard Precautions.	1		(CPI)
Determines the MOI (mechanism of injury) and/or NOI (nature of illness)—patient's chief complaint.	1		(CPI)
Identifies the number of patient(s) and the LOR of each.	1		
Forms general impression—evaluates any extrication issues for each patient(s);considers c-spine stabilization/immobilization.	1		
<b>Primary Assessment</b>			
Assesses airway, breathing, circulation (ABCDs).	1		(CPI)
Provides any necessary interventions related to airway/breathing (life threats)	1		(CPI)
Checks for and controls any major bleeding.	1		(CPI)
Confirms and monitors LOR (AVPU or GCS).	1		
Assess for specialized equipment: head, spine, pelvis, femur	1		(CPI)
Calls for transport, equipment, assistance, ALS, etc.	1		
<b>Secondary Assessment</b>			
Performs detailed head-to-toe body assessment physical exam DCAP-BTLS, OPQRST	1		(CPI)
If injury, exposes and inspects to determine level of emergency and treatment plan	1		
Obtains STAMPLE history from patient and/or witness (if available).	1		
Obtains baseline set of vitals.	1		(CPI)
Provides interventions per protocols.	1		
Reassesses vital signs	1		
Treats for shock.	1		
Prepares patient for transport.	1		
Reassesses vital signs	1
